

- Troubleshooting the Calculator: Common Problems
 - "My Calculator Won't Graph"
 - **DIM Mismatch** means that your Stat Plots are on, hit the 2nd key, then the y= key, then go to option 4 to turn off the plots (hit enter twice on option 4)
 - **ERR:SYNTAX** means that you are likely using a "minus" sign (two above the enter key), instead of the "negative" sign (-) just to the left of the negative.
 - It could also mean that you have junk in one of the lines of your graph, so go to y=, scroll down to see if Y₀= has a bunch of stuff in it, and use the clear button to get rid of it.
 - Always use option 1:Goto when this error comes up, it will “go to” exactly where your error is.
 - **ERR:Window Range** means that you have accidentally set either x- or y-min to a number higher than the respective maximum. make sure your minimums are lower than your maximums using the **WINDOW** button.
 - "I See Weird Stuff on the Y= Window"
 - **Inequality Signs** means that you have the "Inequalz" App running. Hit the APPS button (upper left quadrant of the calculator, near the ALPHA key), scroll until you get the Inequalz App, and use option 2:Quit Inequal
 - **Dark Arrow and Bar on the left of the Y=** means you have the Transform App running, Hit the APPS button (upper left quadrant of the calculator, near the ALPHA key), scroll until you get the Transform App (probably last or near last on your list, so you can just scroll up from the top of the list to get to the bottom), and use option 1:Uninstall.
